BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 25/2022 BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE DOGS AND LICENCE DOG KENNELS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WELLESLEY

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WELLESLEY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

11. KENNEL REQUIREMENTS

Microchipping of Dogs

Remove tattooing option as identification

- 11.1 All Dogs and Puppies (exclusive of nursing Puppies) in a Kennel shall be Microchipped, at all times, in order to be able to properly identify each dog.
- 11.2 For Dogs and Puppies that are adopted or sold by a Kennel, the Microchip information for those dogs shall be recorded by the Kennel and noted on any bill of sale, or other applicable documentation, from the Kennel.

Kennel owners shall comply with new requirement to remove tattooing as a option for identification within one (1) year of the passing of this By-law (August 2025)

Information to be Provided Upon Adoption or Sale of a Dog

ADD:

- 11.10 All Kennels shall provide, for any dog being adopted and/or sold, full medical disclosure to the adopter and/or purchaser of said dog
 - (a) Information brochure: Benefits of registering your dogs microchip
